DESCRIPTION

- The neighborhood of Plaka in the historical center of Athens is located on the footsteps of the Acropolis hill and carries a history of centuries from antiquity to the present day. Aspects of mythology and history invite us to discover them in every street, building, monument. And yet even for the local residents and students' parts of the history are unknown.
- Through this activity we want students to get in touch with history with a different methodology that will make them active participants in knowledge.
- They will have to create the scenario on which the story will unfold, build the map, find the missions, riddles, puzzles that will give the opportunity to discover the history of the monuments and the area as a magical and fascinating adventure. The founding of Athens, tales of ancients gods and heroes will be featured and the students will live as ancient Athenians and as shareholders of the district of Plaka or as they call it the district of the Gods. The adventure will end in the beautiful neoclassical building of the 19th century, that houses the School Life and Education Museum, where the surprises will continue




